

Friuli-Venezia Giulia

Being located in the extreme northern-east Italy, had been influenced culturally by several different populations which were dominant in this country. This region is divided in four provinces: Trieste, Udine, Pordenone and Gorizia. There are everywhere many historic traces of the different populations which had hinabitaed in the past this area like Celts, Longbards, Romans. Traditionally, people living in this country were given to agriculture. During the second half of 20th century some industrial centers had been devoleped, in particular steel, shipyard, wood industries; beside to these, even many small handicraft factories were born at that time as well as a high developed service sector. All together these economic sectors represent the strong point of economy in this region. Nowaday, agriculture, even though having much less employers than earlier, plays an important role, not only economic, but also as environment conservation. At the same time, innovation technology within quality food area (San Daniele-ham, Montasio-cheese, wine), is one of the strong points of the primary sector.
